9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL  
10 SERVICES, OPERATING EXPENSES, AND GRANTS OF THE  
11 UALR LITERACY COACHES PROGRAM FOR THE UNIVERSITY  
12 OF ARKANSAS AT LITTLE ROCK FOR THE BIENNIAL  
13 PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2009; AND FOR OTHER  
14 PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

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17 AN ACT FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT  
18 LITTLE ROCK - UALR LITERACY COACHES  
19 PROGRAM APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2007-2009  
20 BIENNIUM.  
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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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26 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - UALR LITERACY COACHES PROGRAM. There is hereby  
27 appropriated, to the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, to be payable  
28 from the University of Arkansas at Little Rock Fund, for personal services,  
29 operating expenses and grants to provide training and support for schools  
30 that are implementing Partnerships in Comprehensive Literacy model schools  
31 for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the sum of .....\$800,000.  
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33 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LITERACY  
35 COACHES PROGRAM - FUNDING ALLOCATION. The University of Arkansas at Little  
36 Rock shall expend the funds appropriated in Section One (1) herein in



1 accordance with the allocations listed below. In the event, the  
 2 appropriation in Section One (1) is not fully funded, each entity listed  
 3 below shall receive an equal, proportionate amount of the available funding.

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 13 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
 14 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
 15 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
 16 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 17 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 18 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
 19 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
 20 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
 21 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
 22 with in disbursement of said funds.

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 24 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 25 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 26 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 27 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
 28 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
 29 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
 30 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
 31 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 33 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 34 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
 35 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
 36 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of

the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.

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
