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1 July 1, 2005, which would result in the Streamlined Sales Tax Agreement 2 becoming effective on October 1, 2005. These contingencies were met, and the Streamlined Sales and Use Tax Agreement went into effect on October 1, 2005. 3 4 Arkansas needs to make additional changes to its laws in order to be in compliance with the agreement. In order to allow the Department of Finance 5 6 and Administration and local businesses additional time to prepare for the 7 changes necessary as the result of this act, all of the sections in this act will become effective on July 1, 2007 July 1, 2009. Thus, any section of 8 9 this act with a specific effective date shall have an effective date of July 1, 2007 July 1, 2009, and not the specific effective date provided in the 10 11 introductory language to the section, and when no effective date was listed 12 in the section, then the effective date will also be July 1, 2007 July 1, 13 2009. 14 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.
