## For An Act To Be Entitled

10 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT  
11 OF ARKANSAS STATE POLICE TO PROVIDE FOR A RELEASE  
12 AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT  
13 OF ARKANSAS STATE POLICE AND THE ESTATE OF ERIN  
14 HAMLEY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

17 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS  
18 STATE POLICE APPROPRIATION.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - RELEASE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT - ESTATE OF  
25 ERIN HAMLEY. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas  
26 State Police, to be payable from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund,  
27 to provide for a Release and Settlement Agreement between the Department of  
28 Arkansas State Police and the Estate of Erin Hamley, the sum of  
29 .....\$1,000,000.  
30

31 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
32 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
33 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
34 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
35 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
36 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal



1 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 2 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 3 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

4  
 5 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 6 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 7 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 8 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
 9 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
 10 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
 11 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
 12 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

13  
 14 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 15 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of  
 16 the Department of Arkansas State Police are, due to unforeseen circumstances,  
 17 insufficient for the Department of Arkansas State Police to continue to  
 18 provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will  
 19 provide the necessary monies for the Department of Arkansas State Police to  
 20 continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act  
 21 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of  
 22 essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared  
 23 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the  
 24 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and  
 25 after the date of its passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved  
 26 nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of  
 27 the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill  
 28 is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become  
 29 effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.
