31	SECTION 2. COMPLI	ANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of	funds authoriz	ed

5 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 6 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 7 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 8 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 9 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 10 11 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 12 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

14 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 15 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of 16 the Department of Arkansas State Police are, due to unforeseen circumstances, 17 insufficient for the Department of Arkansas State Police to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will 18 provide the necessary monies for the Department of Arkansas State Police to 19 20 continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act 21 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of 22 essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared 23 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and 24 after the date of its passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved 25 26 nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of 27 the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill 28 is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become 29 effective on the date the last house overrides the veto. 30 31

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
