9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT
10 OF ARKANSAS STATE POLICE TO PROVIDE FOR A RELEASE
11 AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT
12 OF ARKANSAS STATE POLICE AND THE ESTATE OF ERIN
13 HAMLEY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

16 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS
17 STATE POLICE APPROPRIATION.
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - RELEASE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT - ESTATE OF
24 ERIN HAMLEY. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas
25 State Police, to be payable from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund,
26 to provide for a Release and Settlement Agreement between the Department of
27 Arkansas State Police and the Estate of Erin Hamley, the sum of
28\$1,000,000.
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30 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
31 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
32 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
33 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
34 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
35 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
36 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by



1 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
2 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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4 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
5 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
6 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
7 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
8 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
9 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
10 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
11 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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13 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
14 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
15 the Department of Arkansas State Police are, due to unforeseen circumstances,
16 insufficient for the Department of Arkansas State Police to continue to
17 provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will
18 provide the necessary monies for the Department of Arkansas State Police to
19 continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act
20 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of
21 essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared
22 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
23 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and
24 after the date of its passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved
25 nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of
26 the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill
27 is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become
28 effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.
