4 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 5 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 6 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 7 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 8 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 9 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 10 11 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

13 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of 14 15 the Department of Arkansas State Police are, due to unforeseen circumstances, 16 insufficient for the Department of Arkansas State Police to continue to 17 provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Department of Arkansas State Police to 18 continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act 19 20 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of 21 essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared 22 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the 23 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved 24 nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of 25 26 the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill 27 is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto. 28 29 /s/ Joint Budget Committee 30 31 32
