9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR OPERATING  
10 EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS CRIME INFORMATION  
11 CENTER - ARKANSAS REAL-TIME ELECTRONIC LOGBOOK  
12 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2009; AND  
13 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS CRIME  
16 INFORMATION CENTER - ARKANSAS REAL-TIME  
17 ELECTRONIC LOGBOOK APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
18 2007-2009 BIENNIUM.  
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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25 *SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the*  
26 *Arkansas Crime Information Center - Arkansas Real-Time Electronic Logbook for*  
27 *the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees*  
28 *whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform*  
29 *Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or*  
30 *its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any*  
31 *position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in*  
32 *dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification*  
33 *and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are*  
34 *hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and*  
35 *Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.*

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8 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS REAL-TIME ELECTRONIC LOGBOOK. There

9 is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Crime Information Center, to be

10 payable from the Crime Information System Fund, for operating expenses of the

11 Arkansas Crime Information Center - Arkansas Real-Time Electronic Logbook for

12 the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the following:

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26 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING

28 TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, the Chief Fiscal

29 Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the

30 State Treasurer the sum of Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$900,000) from the

31 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts to the Crime

32 Information System Fund for the costs of the "Arkansas Real-Time Electronic

33 Logbook."

34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007

35 through June 30, 2009.

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1 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
2 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
3 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
4 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
5 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
6 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
7 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
8 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
9 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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11 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
12 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
13 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
14 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
15 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
16 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
17 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
18 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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20 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
21 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
22 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
23 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of  
24 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
25 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
26 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the  
27 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
28 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
29 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
30 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
