- 1 TRANSFER. On July 1, 2007, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall
- 2 transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor
- 3 of the State the sum of twenty six million dollars (\$26,000,000) from the
- 4 General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to the Alternative Fuels Development

- 9 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
