On July 1, 2007, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall 2 transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum of eleven million dollars (\$11,000,000) from the General 3 4 Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to the Alternative Fuels Development Fund to 5 provide funds for the appropriations provided herein. 6 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007 7 through June 30, 2009. 8 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 34 35 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 36
