25	SECTION 1. APPROPRIAT	TION - HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENTS AND	MAINTENANCE. There is

32	SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized		
33	by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds		
34	made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the		
35	restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and		
36	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary		



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Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

6 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 7 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 8 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 9 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 10 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 11 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 12 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 13 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 14

15 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 16 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 17 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and approval is 18 essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this 19 20 Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular 21 Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its 22 passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon the proper 23 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, 24 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in 25 26 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. 27 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become 28 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor 29 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is 30 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides 31 the veto. 32 33 34 35
