8	by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds			
9	made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the			
10	restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

26	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is four	nd and determined by the General		
27	Assembly, that funds provided by the General	al Assembly for the operations of		
28	the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission	n are, due to unforeseen		
29	circumstances, insufficient for the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission			
30	to continue to provide essential government	tal services; that the provisions		
31	of this act will provide the necessary moni	ies for the Arkansas State Game and		
32	Fish Commission to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective			
33	date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration			
34	and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is			
35	hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate			
36	preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force			

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     and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
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     If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
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     effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
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     may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
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     overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
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     the veto.
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
