10	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
11	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the storage of original
12	warrants for a prolonged period places a burden on the operations of the
13	Auditor of State and that the provisions of this act will provide a more
14	cost-efficient and effective method of storing warrants, which will
15	correspondingly improve access to warrants. Therefore, an emergency is
16	declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the
17	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2007.
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
