21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 60, Subchapter 2 is amended
24 to add an additional section to read as follows:

25 6-60-213. Undergraduate course credit for high school students
26 completing the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program.

27 (a) As used in this section, "International Baccalaureate Diploma
28 Program" means the curriculum and examinations leading to an International
29 Baccalaureate diploma awarded by the International Baccalaureate
30 Organization.

31 (b) A state-supported institution of higher education in this state
32 that offers freshman-level courses shall adopt and implement a policy to
33 grant at least twenty-four (24) semester credit hours or equivalent
34 undergraduate course credit to entering freshman students who have
35 successfully completed the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program.

36 (c)(1) The policy shall establish the institution's conditions for



1 granting the credit hours or course credit, including the minimum required
2 scores in courses constituting the International Baccalaureate Diploma
3 Program.
