Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE COLLEGE CREDIT TO ENTERING FRESHMEN WHO HAVE SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED THE INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE DIPLOMA PROGRAM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO PROVIDE COLLEGE CREDIT TO ENTERING FRESHMEN WHO HAVE SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED THE INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE DIPLOMA PROGRAM. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 60, Subchapter 2 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-60-213. Undergraduate course credit for high school students completing the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program.
(a) As used in this section, "International Baccalaureate Diploma

## Program" means the curriculum and examinations leading to an International

 Baccalaureate diploma awarded by the International Baccalaureate Organization.(b) A state-supported institution of higher education in this state that offers freshman-level courses shall adopt and implement a policy to grant at least twenty-four (24) semester credit hours or equivalent undergraduate course credit to entering freshman students who have successfully completed the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program.
(c)(1) The policy shall establish the institution's conditions for
granting the credit hours or course credit, including the minimum required scores in courses constituting the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program.
