BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-11-111(c), concerning the annual report of the State Board of Education, is amended to read as follows:
(c)(l) Such reports Each annual report of the state board shall be printed by the state board and distributed among the various school officers of the state.
(2) The report shall include without limitation, the information required by § 6-20-2304(b).

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-20-2304 is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

6-20-2304. Miscellaneous.
(a) The State Board of Education shall have the authority, acting pursuant to its rulemaking powers, to adopt regulations for the implementation of the provisions of this subchapter.
(b) The state board shall provide access to information developed by the General Assembly evidencing its legislative intent concerning public school funding by the following methods:
(1) Including a link to the information on the Department of Education website; and
(2) Mailing a copy to each school district board of directors as part of the state board's annual report.
