AN ACT TO PROVIDE ARKANSAS HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS
WITH COMPREHENSIVE INFORMATION CONCERNING COLLEGE
SCHOLARSHIPS AND STATE-FUNDED PROGRAMS FOR
DEVELOPING TECHNICAL JOB SKILLS; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT TO PROVIDE ARKANSAS HIGH SCHOOL
STUDENTS WITH COMPREHENSIVE INFORMATION
CONCERNING COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS AND
STATE-FUNDED PROGRAMS FOR DEVELOPING
TECHNICAL JOB SKILLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-5-403, concerning scope of the Higher Education Awareness Program, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(d)(1) The Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board, working in conjunction with state-supported institutions of higher education, private institutions of higher education that wish to participate, the Department of Education, and the Department of Workforce Education shall annually compile information for Arkansas high school students on:

(A) Academic scholarships for freshmen entering institutions of higher education in the state; and

(B) State-funded programs that provide opportunities for developing technical job skills and apprenticeships.



1 (2)(A) The Department of Education shall provide the information
2 annually to all public high school counselors in the state.

3 (B) Each public high school counselor shall annually
4 provide the information received from the Department of Education to students
5 in the public high school where he or she is employed.
