29	(a) <u>(l)</u> A person	with a disability, which, as determ	nined by a licen	sed
30	physician is temporary	in nature as opposed to permanent,	may apply to th	.e
31	Office of Motor Vehicle	for a temporary person-with-a-disa	ability special

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- authorizing the use of parking spaces reserved exclusively for persons with disabilities.
- (2)(A) For every application for a temporary special certificate
  issued under this section, the Department of Finance and Administration shall
  produce a photo identification card containing a color photograph of the
  person with a disability who applies for the temporary special certificate.
- 7 (B) The requirement of a photo identification card in this subsection shall not apply to an organization in the business of transporting persons with a disability as described in § 27-15-308(a).
- 10 (b) The temporary special certificate shall conform in size, color, 11 and construction as may be specified by federal rules issued by the United 12 States Secretary of Transportation, pursuant to Pub. L. No. 100-641.
- (c) When the temporary special certificate is displayed on the inside rearview mirror, or the dashboard if the vehicle is of a type that does not have an inside rearview mirror, of a vehicle described in § 27-15-303 that is transporting the person to whom the temporary special certificate was issued, the owner or operator of the motor vehicle shall be entitled to the same parking privileges as the owner or operator of a vehicle bearing a special license plate provided under § 27-15-308(a).
  - (d)(1) The temporary special certificate shall be issued free of charge and shall expire three (3) months from the last day of the month in which it is issued.
- 23 (2)(A) The photo identification card that is issued to
  24 correspond with the temporary special certificate shall be issued upon
  25 payment of a transaction fee of five dollars (\$5.00) and shall expire three
  26 (3) months from the last day of the month in which it is issued.
- 27 (B) The transaction fee shall be deposited as special
  28 revenue into the State Central Services Fund to be used exclusively for the
  29 benefit of the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and
  30 Administration.
- 31 (C) The transaction fee shall be credited as supplemental
  32 and in addition to all other funds as may be deposited for the benefit of the
  33 division.
- 35 <u>(D) The transaction fee shall not be considered or</u> 35 <u>credited to the division as direct revenue.</u>

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SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-15-306 is amended to read as follows: 1 27-15-306. Enforcement. 2 (a) Any law enforcement official in this state is authorized to may 3 4 enter upon the any public parking space, public parking lot, or public 5 parking facility of any public agency of in this state for the purpose of 6 enforcing the provisions of this subchapter with respect to accessible 7 parking for a person with a disability. (b) Any law enforcement officer in this state is authorized to may 8 9 enter upon the parking space, parking lot, or parking facility of any private agency in this state for the purpose of enforcing the provisions of this 10 11 subchapter with respect to accessible parking for a person with a disability. 12 13 SECTION 3. Effective January 1, 2008, Arkansas Code § 27-15-308 is 14 amended to read as follows: 15 27-15-308. Special license plates and certificates. 16 (a)(1) An owner of a motor vehicle described in § 27-15-303 may apply 17 to the Office of Motor Vehicle for issuance of one (1) special license plate, to be affixed to his or her vehicle, if the applicant, a dependent of the 18 19 applicant, or any individual who depends primarily on the applicant for more 20 than sixty percent (60%) of his or her transportation is disabled under the 21 definition of a person with a disability, as defined in § 27-15-302(3), or if 22 the applicant is an organization owning the vehicle for which the special 23 license is to be affixed and the organization's vehicle is primarily used to 24 transport persons with disabilities, as defined in § 27-15-302(3). 25 (2) For every application for a special license plate issued 26 under this section, the Department of Finance and Administration shall 27 produce a photo identification card containing a color photograph of the 28 person with a disability who is either: 29 (A) Applying for the special license plate; or 30 (B) Being transported by the vehicle for which the special 31 license plate is issued. 32 (3)(A) An owner of a motor vehicle that is issued a special 33 license plate under this section shall submit every two (2) years to the 34 Office of Motor Vehicle a physician recertification of the person with a 35 disability to be transported by the vehicle to continue to qualify for the

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special license plate.

- 1 (B) The photo identification card required in this 2 subsection must be renewed every two (2) years. 3 (4)(A) An organization that owns or leases a motor vehicle 4 described in § 27-15-303 that is used in the business of transporting persons 5 with disabilities may apply to the Office of Motor Vehicle for issuance of 6 one (1) special license plate to be affixed to the vehicle for each vehicle 7 used in the business. 8 (B) The requirements of a photo identification card and 9 physician recertification in this subsection (a) shall not apply to an applicant in the business of transporting persons with a disability as 10 11 described in this subsection. 12 (b)(1) The special license plate issued by the office shall contain 13 the international symbol of access, and a white figure on international blue 14 background. 15 (2) The special license plate shall be issued at no additional 16 charge. 17 (c)(1)(A) A person with a disability may apply to the office for a 18 special person-with-a-disability certificate, subject to the photo identification card requirements of subsection (a) of this section. 19 20 (2) The special certificate shall conform in size, color, and 21 construction as may be specified by federal rules issued by the United States 22 Secretary of Transportation, pursuant to Pub. L. No. 100-641. 2.3 (3) When the special certificate is displayed on the inside 24 rearview mirror, or the dashboard if the vehicle is of a type that does not 25 have an inside rearview mirror, of a vehicle described in § 27-15-303 that is 26 transporting the person to whom the special certificate was issued, the owner 27 or operator of the motor vehicle shall be entitled to the same parking 28 privileges as the owner or operator of a vehicle bearing a special license 29 plate provided under subsection (a) of this section. 30 (4) The special certificate shall be issued free of charge and 31 shall expire two (2) years from the last day of the month in which it is 32 issued. Provided, however, the applicant shall not be required to obtain 33 recertification of his or her qualifying disability in order to renew the 34 special certificate.
  - (5)(A) If a person to whom a special certificate or license plate has been issued moves to another state, the person shall surrender the

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1 special certificate or plate to the office. 2 (B) If a person to whom a special certificate or license 3 plate has been issued dies, the special certificate or license plate shall be 4 returned to the office within thirty (30) days after the death of the person 5 to whom the special certificate or plate was issued. 6 (6)(A) The photo identification card issued under this section 7 shall be issued upon payment of a transaction fee of five dollars (\$5.00) and 8 shall expire two (2) years from the last day of the month in which it is 9 issued. 10 (B) The transaction fee shall be deposited as special 11 revenue into the State Central Services Fund to be used exclusively for the benefit of the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and 12 Administration. 13 14 (C) The transaction fee shall be credited as supplemental 15 and in addition to all other funds as may be deposited for the benefit of the 16 division. 17 (D) The transaction fee shall not be considered or credited to the division as direct revenue. 18 19 20 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 27-15-312(a), regarding parking privileges for persons with disabilities, is amended to read as follows: 21 22 (a)(1) A vehicle displaying a special license plate or special 23 certificate and being used for the actual transporting of a person with a disability is permitted exclusive parking privileges in those areas 24 25 designated for parking only by persons with disabilities. 26 (2) Vehicles A parking space reserved for a person with a 27 disability that is designated as "van accessible" shall be used exclusively 28 by vehicles that load or unload a wheelchair, or other related mobility 29 device three- or four-wheeled scooter, or similar device that is powered by 30 an independent source and that is commonly used to transport persons who have limited or no use of their legs shall be authorized to load or unload or 31 32 otherwise use those parking spaces reserved exclusively for persons with 33 disabilities and designated "van accessible". 34

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SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 27-15-315 is amended to read as follows:

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1	27-13-313. Signs regulatory in nature.		
2	(a) For the purposes of this subchapter and for the purposes of		
3	enforcing any law of this state relating to penalizing owners or operators of		
4	vehicles who park vehicles in spaces designated for use by persons with		
5	disabilities and whose vehicles do not properly and legally display a special		
6	license plate or a special certificate provided under this subchapter, it		
7	shall be assumed presumed that the identification of areas designated for use		
8	by persons with disabilities is regulatory in nature and that the identified		
9	areas are intended for exclusive use by persons with disabilities whose		
10	vehicles are properly identified and that penalties should be imposed on the		
11	owner or operator of a vehicle parked in those areas whose vehicle is not		
12	properly identified.		
13	(b) For the purposes of this subchapter and for the purposes of		
14	enforcing any laws of this state related to parking areas for persons with		
15	disabilities, sign R7-8, listed in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control		
16	Devices (Rev. 12/79) shall be Any of the following designations that are		
17	displayed on each parking space for persons with disabilities and shall be		
18	enforced as provided under this subchapter and are regulatory in nature $\pm$ :		
19	$\frac{(c)}{(1)}$ The blue and white international symbol of access on a		
20	sign or on the pavement, or both;		
21	(2) accompanied by appropriate regulatory language, including,		
22	but not limited to, "Handicapped Parking", "Reserved for Handicapped",		
23	"Permit Required - Towing Enforced", etc., may be used in lieu of sign R7-8		
24	if the sign was erected prior to January 1, 1992, and shall be regulatory in		
25	nature. A sign that states any of the following:		
26	(A) "Disabled Parking";		
27	(B) "Van Accessible";		
28	(C) "Handicapped Parking";		
29	(D) "Reserved for Handicapped"; or		
30	(E) "Permit Required - Towing Enforced"; or		
31	(3) A sign that is compliant with R7-8, R7-8a, or R7-8b of the		
32	Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices promulgated by the Federal Highway		
33	Administration of the United States Department of Transportation.		
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35	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 27-16-706 is amended to read as follows:		
36	The driver's license test shall include written questions concerning:		

1	(1) The effects of the consumption of beverage alcohol products			
2	and the use of illegal drugs, prescription drugs, and nonprescription drugs			
3	on the ability of a person to operate a motor vehicle; and			
4	(2) The legal and financial consequences resulting from			
5	violations of the state's laws prohibiting the operation of a motor vehicle			
6	while under the influence of alcohol or drugs;			
7	(3) Accessible parking for a person with a disability; and			
8	(4) Penalties for the unauthorized use of parking designated for			
9	the exclusive use of a person with a disability.			
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11	SECTION 7. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 18, Subchapter 1 is amended

13	27-18-110. Instruction on accessible parking for persons with			
14	disabilities.			
15	(a) The driver's instruction manual issued by the Department of			
16	Arkansas State Police shall include information related to accessible parking			
17	for a person with a disability, including without limitation:			
18	(1) The importance of accessible parking for a person with a			
19	disability; and			
20	(2) The penalties for the unauthorized use of parking designated			
21	for the exclusive use of a person with a disability.			
22	(b) The Department of Arkansas State Police may coordinate with the			
23	Arkansas Governor's Commission on People with Disabilities in developing			
24	information to include in the manual.			
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26	SECTION 8. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 16, Subchapter 5 is amended			
27	to add an additional section to read as follows:			
28	6-16-508. Accessible parking for persons with disabilities.			
29	(a) After receiving approval of materials from the Commissioner of			
30	Education and the Director of the Division of Health of the Department of			
31	Health and Human Services, the Arkansas Governor's Commission on People with			
32	Disabilities may provide educational and instructional materials regarding			
33	accessible parking for persons with disabilities to school districts for use			
34	in the classroom.			
35	(b) Driver education courses and high school health classes shall			
36	include information or instructional materials regarding accessibility issues			

1	for persons with disabilities.
2	(c) Inclusion of educational information or instructional materials
3	under this section is mandated beginning with the 2008-2009 school fiscal
4	year.
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
