Prater 5 6 7 For An Act To Be Entitled 8 AN ACT TO REVISE AND MODERNIZE THE ACCESS TO 9 PARKING FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES ACT, § 27-10 11 15-301 ET SEQ.; TO ENSURE THAT DRIVER EDUCATION PROGRAMS AND THE DRIVER'S INSTRUCTION MANUAL 12 13 INCLUDE INFORMATION ABOUT PARKING FOR PERSONS WITH A DISABILITY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. 14 15 **Subtitle** 16 TO REVISE AND MODERNIZE THE ACCESS TO 17 PARKING FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES 18 ACT AND TO ENSURE THAT BEGINNING DRIVERS 19 ARE GIVEN INFORMATION AND TESTED ON 20 21 PARKING FOR PERSONS WITH A DISABILITY. 22 23 24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: 25 26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-15-306 is amended to read as follows: 27-15-306. Enforcement. 27 28 (a) Any law enforcement official in this state is authorized to may 29 enter upon the any public parking space, public parking lot, or public 30 parking facility of any public agency of in this state for the purpose of enforcing the provisions of this subchapter with respect to accessible 31 32 parking for a person with a disability. 33 (b) Any law enforcement officer in this state is authorized to may enter upon the parking space, parking lot, or parking facility of any private 34 35 agency in this state for the purpose of enforcing the provisions of this 36 subchapter with respect to accessible parking for a person with a disability.

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2	SECTION 2. Effective January 1, 2008, Arkansas Code § 27-15-308 is
3	amended to read as follows:
4	27-15-308. Special license plates and certificates.
5	(a)(1) An owner of a motor vehicle described in § 27-15-303 may apply
6	to the Office of Motor Vehicle for issuance of one (1) special license plate,
7	to be affixed to his or her vehicle, if the applicant, a dependent of the
8	applicant, or any individual who depends primarily on the applicant for more
9	than sixty percent (60%) of his or her transportation is disabled under the
10	definition of a person with a disability, as defined in § 27-15-302(3), or if
11	the applicant is an organization owning the vehicle for which the special
12	license is to be affixed and the organization's vehicle is primarily used to
13	transport persons with disabilities, as defined in § 27-15-302(3).
14	(2)(A) Except as provided under subsection (d) of this section,
15	for every application for a special license plate issued under this section,
16	the Department of Finance and Administration shall produce a photo
17	identification card containing a color photograph of the person with a
18	disability who is either:
19	(i) Applying for the special license plate; or
20	(ii) Being transported by the vehicle for which the
21	special license plate is issued.
22	(B) The photo identification card issued under subsection
23	(a) of this section shall be carried on the person for verification of
24	<u>identity.</u>
25	(3)(A) An owner of a motor vehicle that is issued a special
26	license plate under this section shall submit every four (4) years to the
27	Office of Motor Vehicle a physician recertification of the person with a
28	disability to be transported by the vehicle to continue to qualify for the
29	special license plate.
30	(B) The photo identification card required in this
31	subsection must be renewed every four (4) years.
32	(4)(A) An organization that owns or leases a motor vehicle
33	described in § 27-15-303 that is used in the business of transporting persons
34	with disabilities may apply to the Office of Motor Vehicle for issuance of
35	one (1) special license plate to be affixed to the vehicle for each vehicle
36	used in the business.

- 1 (B) The requirements of a photo identification card and
- 2 physician recertification in this subsection (a) shall not apply to an
- 3 applicant in the business of transporting persons with a disability as
- 4 described in this subsection.
- 5 (b)(1) The special license plate issued by the office shall contain
- 6 the international symbol of access, and a white figure on international blue
- 7 background.
- 8 (2) The special license plate shall be issued at no additional
- 9 charge.
- 10 (c)(1)(A) A person with a disability may apply to the office for a
- 11 special person-with-a-disability certificate, subject to the photo
- 12 identification card requirements of subsection (a) of this section.
- 13 (2) The special certificate shall conform in size, color, and
- 14 construction as may be specified by federal rules issued by the United States
- 15 Secretary of Transportation, pursuant to Pub. L. No. 100-641.
- 16 (3) When the special certificate is displayed on the inside
- 17 rearview mirror, or the dashboard if the vehicle is of a type that does not
- 18 have an inside rearview mirror, of a vehicle described in § 27-15-303 that is
- 19 transporting the person to whom the special certificate was issued, the owner
- 20 or operator of the motor vehicle shall be entitled to the same parking
- 21 privileges as the owner or operator of a vehicle bearing a special license
- 22 plate provided under subsection (a) of this section.
- 23 (4) The special certificate shall be issued free of charge and
- 24 shall expire two (2) four (4) years from the last day of the month in which
- 25 it is issued. Provided, however, the applicant shall not be required to
- 26 obtain recertification of his or her qualifying disability in order to renew
- 27 the special certificate.
- 28 (5)(A) If a person to whom a special certificate or license
- 29 plate has been issued moves to another state, the person shall surrender the
- 30 special certificate or plate to the office.
- 31 (B) If a person to whom a special certificate or license
- 32 plate has been issued dies, the special certificate or license plate shall be
- 33 returned to the office within thirty (30) days after the death of the person
- 34 to whom the special certificate or plate was issued.
- 35 (6)(A) The photo identification card issued under this section
- 36 shall be issued upon payment of a transaction fee of five dollars (\$5.00) and

1	shall expire four (4) years from the last day of the month in which it is
2	issued.
3	(B) The transaction fee shall be deposited as special
4	revenue into the State Central Services Fund to be used exclusively for the
5	benefit of the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and
6	Administration.
7	(C) The transaction fee shall be credited as supplemental
8	and in addition to all other funds as may be deposited for the benefit of the
9	division.
10	(D) The transaction fee shall not be considered or
11	credited to the division as direct revenue.
12	(d)(1) In lieu of the photo identification card issued under this
13	section, a person who holds a valid driver's license or identification card
14	issued under the laws of this state may choose to have an endorsement on his
15	or her driver's license or identification card that authorizes parking in
16	areas designated as parking for a person with a disability.
17	(2) If a driver's license endorsement or identification card
18	endorsement is chosen under this section, then the issuance and expiration of
19	the driver's license shall correspond with the expiration date of the special
20	person-with-a-disability certificate issued under this section.
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22	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 27-15-312(a), regarding parking privileges
23	for persons with disabilities, is amended to read as follows:
24	(a)(l) A vehicle displaying a special license plate or special
25	certificate and being used for the actual transporting of a person with a
26	disability is permitted exclusive parking privileges in those areas
27	designated for parking only by persons with disabilities.
28	(2) (A) Vehicles Except as provided under subdivision (a)(2)(B)
29	of this section, a parking space reserved for a person with a disability that
30	is designated as "van accessible" shall be used exclusively by vehicles that
31	load or unload a wheelchair, or other related mobility device three- or four-
32	wheeled scooter, or similar device that is powered by an independent source
33	and that is commonly used to transport persons who have limited or no use of
34	their legs shall be authorized to load or unload or otherwise use those
35	parking spaces reserved exclusively for persons with disabilities and
36	designated "van accessible".

1	(B) If the parking lot or parking facility has only one
2	(1) parking space reserved for a person with a disability, then the
3	limitation of use under subsection (a)(2)(A) shall not apply
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5	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 27-15-315 is amended to read as follows:
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7	27-15-315. Signs regulatory in nature.
8	(a) For the purposes of this subchapter and for the purposes of
9	enforcing any law of this state relating to penalizing owners or operators of
10	vehicles who park vehicles in spaces designated for use by persons with
11	disabilities and whose vehicles do not properly and legally display a special
12	license plate or a special certificate provided under this subchapter, it
13	shall be assumed presumed that the identification of areas designated for use
14	by persons with disabilities is regulatory in nature and that the identified
15	areas are intended for exclusive use by persons with disabilities whose
16	vehicles are properly identified and that penalties should be imposed on the
17	owner or operator of a vehicle parked in those areas whose vehicle is not
18	properly identified.
19	(b) For the purposes of this subchapter and for the purposes of
20	enforcing any laws of this state related to parking areas for persons with
21	disabilities, sign R7-8, listed in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control
22	Devices (Rev. 12/79) shall be Any of the following designations that are
23	displayed on each parking space for persons with disabilities and $\underline{visible}$ to
24	the driver's eye level shall be enforced as provided under this subchapter
25	and are regulatory in nature-:
26	$\frac{(e)}{(1)}$ The blue and white international symbol of access on a
27	sign or on the pavement, or both;
28	(2) accompanied by appropriate regulatory language, including,
29	but not limited to, "Handicapped Parking", "Reserved for Handicapped",
30	"Permit Required - Towing Enforced", etc., may be used in lieu of sign R7-8
31	if the sign was erected prior to January 1, 1992, and shall be regulatory in
32	nature. A sign that states any of the following:
33	(A) "Disabled Parking";
34	(B) "Van Accessible";
35	(C) "Handicapped Parking";
36	(D) "Reserved for Handicapped"; or

1	(E) "Permit Required - Towing Enforced"; or
2	(3) A sign that is compliant with R7-8, R7-8a, or R7-8b of the
3	Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices promulgated by the Federal Highway
4	Administration of the United States Department of Transportation.
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6	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 27-16-706 is amended to read as follows:
7	The driver's license test shall include written questions concerning:
8	(1) The effects of the consumption of beverage alcohol products
9	and the use of illegal drugs, prescription drugs, and nonprescription drugs
10	on the ability of a person to operate a motor vehicle; and
11	(2) The legal and financial consequences resulting from
12	violations of the state's laws prohibiting the operation of a motor vehicle
13	while under the influence of alcohol or drugs;
14	(3) Accessible parking for a person with a disability; and
15	(4) Penalties for the unauthorized use of parking designated for
16	the exclusive use of a person with a disability.
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18	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 18, Subchapter 1 is amended
19	to add an additional section to read as follows:
20	27-18-110. Instruction on accessible parking for persons with
21	disabilities.
22	(a) The driver's instruction manual issued by the Department of
23	Arkansas State Police shall include information related to accessible parking
24	for a person with a disability, including without limitation:
25	(1) The importance of accessible parking for a person with a
26	disability; and
27	(2) The penalties for the unauthorized use of parking designated
28	for the exclusive use of a person with a disability.
29	(b) The Department of Arkansas State Police may coordinate with the
30	Arkansas Governor's Commission on People with Disabilities in developing
31	information to include in the manual.
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33	SECTION 7. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 16, Subchapter 5 is amended
34	to add an additional section to read as follows:
35	6-16-508. Accessible parking for persons with disabilities.
36	(a) After receiving approval of materials from the Commissioner of

1	Education and the Director of the Division of Health of the Department of
2	Health and Human Services, the Arkansas Governor's Commission on People with
3	Disabilities may provide educational and instructional materials regarding
4	accessible parking for persons with disabilities to school districts for use
5	in the classroom.
6	(b) Driver education courses and high school health classes shall
7	include information or instructional materials regarding accessibility issues
8	for persons with disabilities.
9	(c) Inclusion of educational information or instructional materials
10	under this section is mandated beginning with the 2008-2009 school fiscal
11	year.
