19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-64-1001 is amended to read as follows:
22 5-64-1001. Recordkeeping required.

23 Any manufacturer, wholesaler, retailer, or other person that sells,
24 transfers, or otherwise furnishes any of the following substances to any
25 person in this state shall maintain accurate records of those transactions:

- 26 (1) Phenylpropanolamine;
- 27 (2) Methylamine;
- 28 (3) Ethylamine;
- 29 (4) D-lysergic acid;
- 30 (5) Ergotamine tartrate;
- 31 (6) Diethyl malonate;
- 32 (7) Malonic acid;
- 33 (8) Ethyl malonate;
- 34 (9) Barbituric acid;
- 35 (10) Piperidine;
- 36 (11) N-acetylanthranilic acid;



- 1 (12) Pyrrolidine;
- 2 (13) Anthranilic acid;
- 3 (14) Ephedrine;
- 4 (15) Norpseudoephedrine;
- 5 (16) Phenylacetic acid;
- 6 (17) Morpholine; ~~and~~
- 7 (18) Pseudoephedrine;
- 8 (19) Paint thinner;
- 9 (20) Denatured alcohol;
- 10 (21) Iodine;
- 11 (22) Propane;
- 12 (23) Butane; and
- 13 (24) A product containing lye as a primary ingredient.
