AN ACT TO RECONCILE THE PROVISIONS REGARDING THE
AMOUNT OF AN UNSATISFIED JUDGMENT REQUIRED TO BE
REPORTED FOR PURPOSES OF SUSPENSION OF LICENSE
AND REGISTRATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE MINIMUM AMOUNT OF
UNSATISFIED JUDGMENT REQUIRED FOR
LICENSE SUSPENSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-19-706(a), concerning the duty of courts to report nonpayment of judgments, is amended to read as follows:

(a) Whenever any person fails within thirty (30) days to satisfy any judgment in excess of ~~five hundred dollars (\$500)~~ one thousand dollars (\$1,000), then, upon the written request of the judgment creditor or his or her attorney, it shall be the duty of the clerk of the court, or of the judge of a court which has no clerk, in which the judgment is rendered within this state to forward to the ~~office~~ Office of Driver Services a certified copy of the judgment.
