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1	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 15, Chapter 10 is amended to add an
2	additional subchapter to read as follows:
3	SUBCHAPTER 8. The Arkansas Renewable Fuels Production Accountability
4	<u>Act.</u>
5	
6	<u>15-10-801. Title.</u>
7	This subchapter shall be known and may be cited as the "Arkansas
8	Renewable Fuels Production Accountability Act".
9	
10	15-10-802. Findings — Purpose.
11	(a) The General Assembly finds that:
12	(1) The production of renewable fuels in Arkansas derived from
13	Arkansas feedstock is vital to the health of the agricultural economy of
14	Arkansas;
15	(2) The use of renewable domestic fuels such as ethanol and
16	biodiesel will increase available supplies of motor fuels without increasing
17	dependency on foreign oil;
18	(3) The construction and operation of facilities manufacturing
19	renewable fuels will serve as an economic boost to many rural areas of this
20	state; and
21	(4) Assuring that the optimal use of Arkansas grown crops in the
22	manufacturing of renewable fuels by facilities located in Arkansas will
23	provide a deeper, broader, and longer-lasting benefit to the state's economy
24	and is a matter of public policy.
25	(b) The purpose of this subchapter is to:
26	(1) Ensure that Arkansas farmers have the opportunity to have
27	Arkansas-harvested crops purchased as feedstock by operators of renewable
28	fuels manufacturing facilities in Arkansas by requiring the collection and
29	reporting of information regarding the operation of the facilities; and
30	(2) Provide for the certification of the facilities for certain
31	programs provided by this state.
32	
33	<u>15-10-803. Definition.</u>
34	As used in this subchapter, "renewable fuels manufacturing facility"
35	means a facility that produces ethanol, biodiesel, or other fuel additives
36	and that is required to register with the United States Environmental

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1	Protection Agency under 40 C.F.R. Part 79.
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3	15-10-804. Purchase of feedstock by operators of renewable fuels
4	manufacturing facilities.
5	(a)(1) Beginning July 1, 2008, renewable fuels manufacturing
6	facilities operating in Arkansas and deriving ethanol from the distillation
7	of corn shall use as feedstock at least twenty percent (20%) of the corn crop
8	harvested in Arkansas.
9	(2) In succeeding years, the minimum percentage of Arkansas
10	harvested corn used to produce renewable fuels in Arkansas renewable fuels
11	manufacturing facilities shall be at least the same percentage of corn used
12	nationally to produce renewable fuels as reported by the Office of the Chief
13	Economist of the United States Department of Agriculture.
14	(b)(1) Beginning July 1, 2008, renewable fuels manufacturing
15	facilities operating in Arkansas and deriving biodiesel from soybeans and
16	other crops shall use as feedstock at least two and one-half percent (2.5%)
17	of the soybean crop harvested in Arkansas.
18	(2) In succeeding years, the minimum percentage of Arkansas
19	harvested soybeans used to produce renewable fuels in Arkansas renewable
20	fuels manufacturing facilities shall be the percentage of soybeans used
21	nationally to produce renewable fuels as reported by the Office of the Chief
22	Economist of the United States Department of Agriculture.
23	(c) As additional crops are used in the production of renewable fuels
24	at renewable fuels manufacturing facilities in Arkansas, there shall be a
25	presumption that renewable fuel manufacturing facilities operating in
26	Arkansas shall use Arkansas harvested crops in a percentage rate at least
27	equal to the percentage of the crops' use nationally in the production of
28	renewable fuel as reported by the United States Department of Agriculture's
29	Office of the Chief Economist.
30	(d)(l) This section shall not be effective until six (6) months after
31	the average wholesale price of a gallon of Arkansas-manufactured ethanol,
32	less any federal alcohol fuel mixture tax credit, is equal to or lower than
33	the average wholesale price of a gallon of regular unleaded gasoline in
34	Arkansas for a period of not less than sixty (60) days, as determined by the
35	Secretary of the Arkansas Agriculture Department.
36	(2) The secretary shall gather pricing information to be used in

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1	making the determination required by this section.
2	(3) In gathering the pricing information, the secretary shall
3	rely upon sales in Arkansas and shall use recognized information services,
4	including without limitation the Oil Price Information Service.
5	
6	<u>15-10-805. Notice requirements — Annual report.</u>
7	(a)(1) To improve dissemination of information regarding supply needs
8	of renewable fuels manufacturing facilities operating in Arkansas and to
9	ensure that Arkansas farmers are adequately and timely informed about the
10	feedstock needs of facilities, the operators of each renewable fuels
11	manufacturing facility shall provide notice to the Secretary of the Arkansas
12	Agriculture Department, at least one hundred eighty (180) days before the
13	start of commercial operation of the renewable fuels manufacturing facility.
14	(2) The notice required under subsection (a)(1) of this section
15	shall include the following information:
16	(A) The anticipated production level for the facility's
17	first twelve (12) months of operation;
18	(B) The amount and type of feedstock anticipated to be
19	necessary to meet production levels for the first twelve (12) months of
20	operation;
21	(C) The location where the feedstock originated if already
22	secured; and
23	(D) The steps taken to obtain feedstock from Arkansas
24	harvested crops; and
25	(E) An itemized list of the federal, state, and local
26	grants, loans or incentive program benefits obtained by the facility for the
27	construction or operation of the renewable fuels manufacturing facility.
28	(b) By December 31 of each calendar year, each renewable fuels re
29	manufacturing facility operating in this state shall provide notice to the
30	secretary the anticipated production levels and specific feedstock
31	requirements for the next calendar year so that Arkansas farmers will be able
32	to adjust the crops they intend to plant and harvest during the upcoming
33	growing season.
34	(c)(1) Each renewable fuels manufacturing facility operating in
35	Arkansas shall provide an annual report to the secretary certifying that the
36	renewable fuels manufacturing facility has purchased all of the competitively

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1	priced Arkansas feedstock available during the year's operations.
2	(2) The report required under subdivision (c)(l) of this
3	section, shall include:
4	(A) The production levels for the previous twelve (12)
5	months;
6	(B) The amount and type of feedstock used to achieve the
7	production levels;
8	(C) The location from where the feedstock originated; and
9	(D) The steps taken to obtain Arkansas-harvested
10	feedstock; and
11	
12	(E) An itemized list of the financial benefits the
13	renewable fuels manufacturing facility has received from the state.
14	
15	<u>15-10-806. Rules.</u>
16	The State Plant Board, in consultation with the Secretary of the
17	Arkansas Agriculture Department, shall promulgate rules regarding documenting
18	the information supplied by the renewable fuels manufacturing facilities
19	under this subchapter.
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
