18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-20-118 is amended to read as follows:

21 27-20-118. Restrictions on young children.

22 (a) Except as provided under subsection (b) of this section, it is
23 unlawful for the driver of a motorcycle to allow a child to ride as a
24 passenger on a motorcycle on a street or highway unless the child ~~is at least~~
25 ~~eight (8) years of age.~~

26 (1) Is able to rest the child's entire foot firmly on the
27 passenger floor board that is in the original factory position; or

28 (2) Is able to rest the arch of the child's foot on the
29 passenger peg that is in the original factory position.

30 (b) This section shall not apply to the driver of a motorcycle who is
31 a participant in a parade.
