11	(A) Retired from service with a public law enforcement		
12	department, office, or agency for reasons other than mental disability;		
13	(B) Immediately before retirement was a certified law		
14	enforcement officer authorized by a public law enforcement department,		
15	office, or agency to carry a firearm in the course and scope of his or her		
16	duties;		
17	(C) Has nonforfeitable rights to benefits under the		
18	retirement plan of a public law enforcement department, office, or agency;		
19	(D)(C) Is carrying appropriate written identification		
20	issued by a public law enforcement department, office, or agency identifying		
21	him or her as a retired and former certified law enforcement officer;		
22	$\frac{(E)}{(D)}$ Is not otherwise prohibited under federal law; and		
23	$\frac{(F)(E)}{(E)}$ Has fingerprint impressions on file with the
