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21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-61-531 is amended to read as follows:	•
22	6-61-531. Arkansas Heavy Equipment Operator Training Academy -	
23	Establishment.	
24	(a) The Arkansas Heavy Equipment Operator Training Academy is	
25	established as a satellite center of the University of Arkansas at	
26	Monticello.	
27	(b) The academy shall be the Arkansas single-source academy offeri	ng
28	statewide services and satellite training for the operation of heavy	
29	equipment.	
30	(c) The permanent headquarters of the academy shall be located in	
31	Warren.	
32	(d)(c) The academy may operate programs in cooperation with the	
33	University of Arkansas at Monticello colleges of technology located in	
34	Crossett and McGehee and the Southeast Arkansas Community-Based Education	<u>1</u>
35	Center located in Warren.	
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1 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-61-532(b), regarding the operation of the 2 Arkansas Heavy Equipment Operator Training Academy, is amended to read as 3 follows: 4 (b)(1) The director will report directly to the chancellor regarding 5 the operation of the academy. 6 (2) The director shall be appointed by the Chancellor of the 7 University of Arkansas at Monticello or his or her designee. 8 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-61-533(b), regarding the funding for the 9 10 Arkansas Heavy Equipment Operator Training Academy, is amended to read as 11 follows: 12 (b)(1) The academy shall remain under the supervision of the director, 13 who shall be assisted by the academy coordinator. 14 (2) The Director of the Southeast Arkansas Community Based 15 Education Center shall serve as the director of the academy. If non-formula 16 funding as recommended by the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board or 17 the Executive recommendation is not received from the state to support the operation of the academy, the academy shall be abolished on June 30, 2007, 18 unless continued by other action of the General Assembly or transferred to 19 20 another state agency. 21 22 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 23 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the failure of the Arkansas 24 Heavy Equipment Operator Training Academy as a single-source academy under 25 the University of Arkansas at Monticello could result in the academy's 26 inability to finish training its currently enrolled students; and that the 27 changes in this act are immediately necessary for the continued efficient 28 operation of the academy. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and 29 this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public 30 peace, health, and safety shall become effective on: 31 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor; 32 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, 33 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the 34 bill; or 35 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto. 36
