AN ACT TO ALLOW A SALES AND USE TAX EXEMPTION FOR
THE SALE OF PROSTHETICS TO A DULY LICENSED
PRACTITIONER; TO INCLUDE DENTAL PROSTHESIS IN THE
DEFINITION OF PROSTHETICS; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

TO ALLOW A SALES AND USE TAX EXEMPTION
FOR THE SALE OF PROSTHETICS TO A DULY
LICENSED PRACTITIONER AND TO INCLUDE
DENTAL PROSTHESIS IN THE DEFINITION OF
PROSTHETICS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to allow a sales and use tax exemption for the sale of prosthetics to a duly licensed practitioner and to include dental prosthesis in the definition of prosthetics.
