HOUSE BILL 2365

For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT CONCERNING CIVIL PENALTIES LEVIED BY THE
ARKANSAS STATE BOARD OF ARCHITECTS; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT CONCERNING CIVIL PENALTIES LEVIED
BY THE ARKANSAS STATE BOARD OF
ARCHITECTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-15-203(d)(4)(A)(i), concerning civil penalties levied by the Arkansas State Board of Architects, is amended to read as follows:

(4)(A)(i) After providing notice and a hearing, the examining body may levy civil penalties, in an amount not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for each violation, against those individuals or entities found to be in violation of this chapter or rules and regulations promulgated thereunder. Before the examining body levies a civil penalty in excess of five hundred dollars (\$500), the proposed civil penalty shall be reviewed by the Legislative Council.
