23	(a) The Arkansas Civil War Sesquicen	tennial Commission is created to	
24	assist the Department of Arkansas Heritage	in carrying out its duties and	
25	responsibilities as provided in this chapte	<u>r.</u>	
26	(b) The purpose of the Arkansas Civi	1 War Sesquicentennial Commission	
27	is to:		
28	(1) Promote a suitable statewi	de observance of the	
29	sesquicentennial of the Civil War;		
30	(2) Cooperate and assist natio	(2) Cooperate and assist national, state, and local	
31	organizations with programs and activities	suitable for the sesquicentennial	
32	observance;		
33	(3) Assist in ensuring that any observance of the		
34	sesquicentennial of the Civil War is inclusive and appropriately recognizes		
35	the experiences and points of views of all	people affected by the Civil War;

1	(4) Provide assistance for the development of programs,			
2	projects, and activities on the Civil War that have lasting educational

5	13-13-102 Members.			
6	(a) The Arkansas Civil War Sesquicentennial Commission shall consist			
7	of sixteen (16) members. The members shall elect a chair from among the			
8	commission members every four years.			
9	(b)(1) The Governor shall appoint four (4) members to serve four-year			
10	terms.			
11	(2) The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the			
12	President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall each appoint two (2) members to			
13	serve four-year terms.			
14	(c)(1) These persons shall be residents of Arkansas who are recognized			
15	as being learned and interested in the history and the archeology of this			
16	state and who have demonstrated an interest in preserving the cultural			
17	resources of the state.			
18	(2) These persons shall also have a background in:			
19	(A) Arkansas history;			
20	(B) African-American history; or			
21	(C) Civil War history.			
22	(3)(A) Persons initially appointed by the Governor shall serve			
23	two-year terms. Persons initially appointed by the Speaker of the House of			
24	Representatives shall serve for three-year terms and persons initially			
25	appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall serve four-year			
26	terms.			
27	(B) Subsequent appointees shall serve four-year terms.			
28	(C) Members may be reappointed.			
29	(4) The remaining commission membership shall consist of the			
30	following persons or their designees:			
31	(A) Director of the Department of Arkansas Heritage;			
32	(B) Director of the Department of Arkansas Parks and			
33	Tourism;			
34	(C) Director of the Arkansas History Commission;			
35	(D) Director of the Old State House Museum;			
36	(E) President of the Arkansas Historical Association;			

1	(F) Director of the Arkansas State Library;			
2	(G) Chair of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Commission; and			
3	(H) President of the Arkansas Civil War Heritage Trails			
4	Foundation.			
5	(5) The following persons shall serve in an advisory capacity:			
6	(A) President of the Sons of Confederate Veterans;			
7	(B) President of the United Daughters of the Confederacy;			
8	(C) Superintendent of the Pea Ridge National Military			
9	Park; and			
10	(D) President of the Sons of Union Veterans.			
11	(d) Members of the Arkansas Civil War Sesquicentennial Commission			
12	shall serve without pay but may receive reimbursement in accordance with §			
13	<u>25-16-902.</u>

15	13-13-103. Duties.			
16	The Arkansas Civil War Sesquicentennial Commission shall have the			
17	following duties:			
18	(1) To plan, develop, and carry out programs and activities			
19	appropriate to commemorate the sesquicentennial of the Civil War era and			
20	encourage the development of programs that ensure that the commemoration			
21	results in a positive legacy and has long-term public benefits;			
22	(2) To encourage interdisciplinary examination of the Civil War;			
23	(3) To facilitate Civil War-related activities throughout the			
24	state;			
25	(4) To encourage civic, historical, educational, economic, and			
26	other organizations across the state to organize and participate in			
27	activities to expand the understanding and appreciation of the significance			
28	of the Civil War;			
29	(5) To coordinate and facilitate the public distribution of			
30	scholarly research, publications, and interpretation of the Civil War; and			
31	(6) To provide technical assistance to local organizations and			
32	nonprofit organizations to further the commemoration of the sesquicentennial			
33	of the Civil War.

35	13-13-104. Funding.			
36	The General Assembly shall allocate sufficient funding to support the			

1	activities of the Arkansas Civil War Sesquicentennial Commission.
