28	In this chapter:		
29	(1) "Appoints	ment of agent" means a stateme	ent appointing an agent
30	for service of process f	iled by:

1	(2) "Commercial registered agent" means an individual or a
2	domestic or foreign entity that is listed under § 4-20-106.
3	(3) "Domestic entity" means an entity whose internal affairs are
4	governed by the law of this state.
5	(4) "Entity" means a person that has a separate legal existence
6	or has the power to acquire an interest in real property in its own name
7	other than:
8	(A) an individual;
9	(B) a testamentary, inter vivos, or charitable trust, with
10	the exception of a business trust, statutory trust, or similar trust;
11	(C) an association or relationship that is not a
12	partnership by reason of § 4-46-202(c);
13	(D) a decedent's estate; or
14	(E) a public corporation, government or governmental
15	subdivision, agency, or instrumentality, or a quasi-governmental
16	instrumentality.
17	(5) "Filing entity" means an entity that is created by the
18	filing of a public organic document.
19	(6) "Foreign entity" means an entity other than a domestic
20	entity.
21	(7) "Foreign qualification document" means an application for a
22	certificate of authority or other foreign qualification filing with the
23	Secretary of State by a foreign entity.
24	(8) "Governance interest" means the right under the organic law
25	or organic rules of an entity, other than as a governor, agent, assignee, or
26	proxy, to:
27	(A) receive or demand access to information concerning, or
28	the books and records of, the entity;
29	(B) vote for the election of the governors of the entity;
30	<u>or</u>
31	(C) receive notice of or vote on any or all issues
32	involving the internal affairs of the entity.
33	(9) "Governor" means a person by or under whose authority the
34	powers of an entity are exercised and under whose direction the business and
35	affairs of the entity are managed pursuant to the organic law and organic
36	rules of the entity.

1	(10) "Interest" means:
2	(A) a governance interest in an unincorporated entity;
3	(B) a transferable interest in an unincorporated entity;
4	<u>or</u>
5	(C) a share or membership in a corporation.
6	(11) "Interest holder" means a direct holder of an interest.
7	(12) "Jurisdiction of organization," with respect to an entity,
8	means the jurisdiction whose law includes the organic law of the entity.
9	(13) "Noncommercial registered agent" means a person that is not
10	listed as a commercial registered agent under § 4-20-106 and that is:
11	(A) an individual or a domestic or foreign entity that
12	serves in this state as the agent for service of process of an entity; or
13	(B) the individual who holds the office or other position
14	in an entity that is designated as the agent for service of process pursuant
15	to Section 5(a)(2)(B).
16	(14) "Nonqualified foreign entity" means a foreign entity that
17	is not authorized to transact business in this state pursuant to a filing
18	with the Secretary of State.
19	(15) "Nonresident LLP statement" means:
20	(A) a statement of qualification of a domestic limited
21	liability partnership that does not have an office in this state; or
22	(B) a statement of foreign qualification of a foreign
23	limited liability partnership that does not have an office in this state.
24	(16) "Organic law" means the statutes, if any, other than this
25	[act], governing the internal affairs of an entity.
26	(17) "Organic rules" means the public organic document and
27	private organic rules of an entity.
28	(18) "Person" means an individual, corporation, estate, trust,
29	partnership, limited liability company, business or similar trust,
30	association, joint venture, public corporation, government or governmental
31	subdivision, agency, or instrumentality, or any other legal or commercial
32	<pre>entity.</pre>
33	(19) "Private organic rules" mean the rules, whether or not in a
34	record, that govern the internal affairs of an entity, are binding on all of
35	its interest holders, and are not part of its public organic document, if
36	any.

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2	(20) "Public organic document" means the public record the
3	filing of which creates an entity, and any amendment to or restatement of
4	that record.
5	(21) "Qualified foreign entity" means a foreign entity that is
6	authorized to transact business in this state pursuant to a filing with the
7	Secretary of State.
8	(22) "Record" means information that is inscribed on a tangible
9	$\underline{\text{medium}}$ or that is stored in an electronic or other medium and is $\underline{\text{retrievable}}$
10	in perceivable form.
11	(23) "Registered agent" means a commercial registered agent or a
12	noncommercial registered agent.
13	(24) "Registered agent filing" means:
14	(A) the public organic document of a domestic filing
15	<pre>entity;</pre>
16	(B) a nonresident LLP statement;
17	(C) a foreign qualification document; or
18	(D) an appointment of agent.
19	(25) "Represented entity" means:
20	(A) a domestic filing entity;
21	(B) a domestic or qualified foreign limited liability
22	partnership that does not have an office in this state;
23	(C) a qualified foreign entity;

36	organic law to receive distributions from the entity.

1	(28) "Type," with respect to an entity, means a generic form of

8	<u>4-20-103. Fees.</u>
9	(a) The Secretary of State shall collect the following fees when a
10	filing is made under this chapter:

15	(4) statement of resignation no fee

18	(b) The Secretary of State shall collect the following fees for
19	copying and certifying a copy of any document filed under this chapter:

23	4-20-104. Addresses in filings. Whenever this chapter requires that a
24	filing state an address, the filing must state:
25	(1) an actual street address or rural route box number in this state;
26	<u>and</u>
27	(2) a mailing address in this state, if different from the address
28	under paragraph (1).
29	
30	4-20-105. Appointment of registered agent.
31	(a) A registered agent filing must state:
32	(1) the name of the represented entity's commercial registered
33	agent; or
34	(2) if the entity does not have a commercial registered agent,
35	the name and address of the entity's noncommercial registered agent:
36	(A) the name and address of the entity's registered agent;

1	<u>or</u>
2	(B) the title of an office or other position with the
3	entity if service of process is to be sent to the person holding that office
4	or position, and the address of the business office of that person.
5	(b) The appointment of a registered agent pursuant to subsection
6	(a)(1) or (2) is an affirmation by the represented entity that the agent has
7	consented to serve as such.
8	(c) The Secretary of State shall make available in a record as soon as
9	practicable a daily list of filings that contain the name of a registered
10	agent. The list must:
11	(1) be kept available for at least 14 calendar days;
12	(2) list in alphabetical order the names of the registered
13	agents; and
14	(3) state the type of filing and name of the represented entity
15	making the filing.

17	4-20-106. Listing of commercial registered agent.
18	(a) An individual or a domestic or foreign entity may become listed as
19	a commercial registered agent by filing with the Secretary of State a
20	commercial registered agent listing statement signed by or on behalf of the
21	person which states:
22	(1) the name of the individual or the name, type, and
23	jurisdiction of organization of the entity;
24	(2) that the person is in the business of serving as a
25	commercial registered agent in this state; and
26	(3) the address of a place of business of the person in this
27	state to which service of process and other notice and documents being served
28	on or sent to entities represented by it may be delivered.
29	(b) A commercial registered agent listing statement may include the
30	information regarding acceptance of service of process in a record by the
31	commercial registered agent provided for in § 4-20-113(d).
32	(c) If the name of a person filing a commercial registered agent
33	listing statement is not distinguishable on the records of the Secretary of
34	State from the name of another commercial registered agent listed under this
35	section, the person must adopt a fictitious name that is so distinguishable
36	and use that name in its statement and when it does business in this state as

2 (d) A commercial registered agent listing statement takes effect on 3 filing. 4 (e) The Secretary of State shall note the filing of the commercial 5 registered agent listing statement in the index of filings maintained by the 6 Secretary of State for each entity represented by the registered agent at the 7 time of the filing. The statement has the effect of deleting the address of 8 the registered agent from the registered agent filing of each of those 9 entities. 10 11 4-20-107. Termination of listing of commercial registered agent. 12 (a) A commercial registered agent may terminate its listing as a 13 commercial registered agent by filing with the Secretary of State a 14 commercial registered agent termination statement signed by or on behalf of 15 the agent which states: 16 (1) the name of the agent as currently listed under § 4-20-106; 17 and 18 (2) that the agent is no longer in the business of serving as a 19 commercial registered agent in this state. 20 (b) A commercial registered agent termination statement takes effect 21 on the 31st day after the day on which it is filed. 22 (c) The commercial registered agent shall promptly furnish each entity 23 represented by it with notice in a record of the filing of the commercial registered agent termination statement. 24 25 (d) When a commercial registered agent termination statement takes 26 effect, the registered agent ceases to be an agent for service of process on 27 each entity formerly represented by it. 21	(a) If a noncommercial registered agent changes its name, its address
22	as currently in effect with respect to a represented entity pursuant to § 4-
23	20-105(a), the agent shall file with the Secretary of State, with respect to
24	each entity represented by the agent, a statement of change signed by or on
25	behalf of the agent which states:
26	(1) the name of the entity;
27	(2) the name and address of the agent as currently in effect
28	with respect to the entity;
29	(3) if the name of the agent has changed, its new name; and
30	(4) if the address of the agent has changed, the new address.
31	(b) A statement of change filed under this section takes effect on
32	filing.
33	(c) A noncommercial registered agent shall promptly furnish the
34	represented entity with notice in a record of the filing of a statement of

5	4-20-111. Resignation of registered agent.
6	(a) A registered agent may resign at any time with respect to a
7	represented entity by filing with the Secretary of State a statement of
8	resignation signed by or on behalf of the agent which states:
9	(1) the name of the entity;
10	(2) the name of the agent;
11	(3) that the agent resigns from serving as agent for service of
12	process for the entity; and
13	(4) the name and address of the person to which the agent will
14	send the notice required by subsection (c).
15	(b) A statement of resignation takes effect on the earlier of the 31st
16	day after the day on which it is filed or the appointment of a new registered
17	agent for the represented entity.
18	(c) The registered agent shall promptly furnish the represented entity
19	with notice in a record of the date on which a statement of resignation was
20	filed.
21	(d) When a statement of resignation takes effect, the registered agent
22	ceases to have responsibility for any matter tendered to it as agent for the
23	represented entity. A resignation under this section does not affect any
24	contractual rights the entity may have against the agent or that the agent
25	has against the entity.
26	(e) A registered agent may resign with respect to a represented entity
27	whether or not the entity is in good standing.
28	
29	4-20-112. Appointment of agent by nonfiling or nonqualified foreign
30	<pre>entity.</pre>
31	(a) A domestic entity that is not a filing entity or a nonqualified
32	foreign entity may file with the Secretary of State a statement appointing an
33	agent for service of process signed on behalf of the entity which states:
34	(1) the name, type, and jurisdiction of organization of the
35	entity; and
36	(2) the information required by § 4-20-105(a).

- 1 (b) A statement appointing an agent for service of process takes 2 effect on filing.
 - (c) The appointment of a registered agent under this section does not qualify a nonqualified foreign entity to do business in this state and is not sufficient alone to create personal jurisdiction over the nonqualified foreign entity in this state.
 - (d) A statement appointing an agent for service of process may not be rejected for filing because the name of the entity filing the statement is not distinguishable on the records of the Secretary of State from the name of another entity appearing in those records. The filing of a statement appointing an agent for service of process does not make the name of the entity filing the statement unavailable for use by another entity.
 - (e) An entity that has filed a statement appointing an agent for service of process may cancel the statement by filing a statement of cancellation, which shall take effect upon filing, and must state the name of the entity and that the entity is canceling its appointment of an agent for service of process in this state. A statement appointing an agent for service of process which has not been cancelled earlier is effective for a period of five years after the date of filing.
 - (f) A statement appointing an agent for service of process for a nonqualified foreign entity terminates automatically on the date the entity becomes a qualified foreign entity.

4-20-113. Service of process on entities.

- (a) A registered agent is an agent of the represented entity authorized to receive service of any process, notice, or demand required or permitted by law to be served on the entity.
- (b) If an entity that previously filed a registered agent filing with the Secretary of State no longer has a registered agent, or if its registered agent cannot with reasonable diligence be served, the entity may be served by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, addressed to one or more of the governors of the entity by name at its principal office in accordance with any applicable judicial rules and procedures. The names of the governors and the address of the principal office shall be as shown in the most recent annual report filed with the Secretary of State. If the entity is not required to file an annual report with the Secretary of State,

1	the names of the governors and the address of the principal office shall be
2	as shown in the entity's public organic document. Service is perfected under
3	this subsection at the earliest of:
4	(1) the date the entity receives the mail;
5	(2) the date shown on the return receipt, if signed on behalf of
6	the entity; or
7	(3) five days after its deposit with the United States Postal
8	Service, if correctly addressed and with sufficient postage.
9	(c) If process, notice, or demand cannot be served on an entity
10	pursuant to subsection (a) or (b), service of process may be made by handing
11	a copy to the manager, clerk, or other person in charge of any regular place
12	of business or activity of the entity if the person served is not a plaintiff
13	in the action.
14	(d) Service of process, notice, or demand on a registered agent must
15	be in the form of a written document, except that service may be made on a
16	commercial registered agent in such other forms of a record, and subject to
17	such requirements, as the agent has stated from time to time in its listing
18	under § 4-20-106 that it will accept.
19	(e) Service of process, notice, or demand may be perfected by any
20	other means prescribed by law other than this chapter.
21	
22	4-20-114. Duties of registered agent.
23	The only duties under this chapter of a registered agent who has
24	<pre>complied with this chapter are:</pre>
25	(1) to forward to the represented entity at the address most
26	recently supplied to the agent by the entity any process, notice, or demand
27	that is served on the agent;
28	(2) to provide the notices required by this chapter to the
29	entity at the address most recently supplied to the agent by the entity;
30	(3) if the agent is a noncommercial registered agent, to keep
31	current the information required by § 4-20-105(a) in the most recent
32	registered agent filing for the entity; and
33	(4) if the agent is a commercial registered agent, to keep
34	current the information listed for it under § 4-20-106(a).
35	
36	4-20-115. Jurisdiction and venue.

1	The appointment or maintenance in this state of a registered agent does
2	not by itself create the basis for personal jurisdiction over the represented
3	entity in this state. The address of the agent does not determine venue in an
4	action or proceeding involving the entity.
5	
6	4-20-116. Consistency of application.
7	In applying and construing this Chapter, consideration must be given to
8	$\underline{ \text{the need to promote consistency of the law with respect to its subject matter} \\$
9	among states that enact it.
10	
11	4-20-117. Relation to Electronic Signatures in Global and National
12	Commerce Act.
13	This chapter modifies, limits, and supersedes the federal Electronic
14	Signatures in Global and National Commerce Act 15 U.S.C. Section 7001, et
15	$\underline{\text{seq.}}$, but does not modify, limit, or supersede Section 101(c) of that act (15
16	U.S.C. Section 7001(c)) or authorize delivery of any of the notices described
17	in Section 103(b) of that act 15 U.S.C. Section 7003(b).
18	
19	4-20-118. Savings clause.
20	This chapter does not affect an action or proceeding commenced or right
21	accrued before the effective date of this chapter.
22

24	4-26-501. Registered office and agent required.
25	Each corporation shall have and continuously maintain in this state:
26	(1) A registered office which may be, but need not be, the same
27	as its principal place of business;
28	(2) A registered agent, which agent may be either an individual
29	resident in this state whose business office is identical with such
30	registered office, or a domestic corporation, or a foreign corporation
31	authorized to transact business in this state, having a business office
32	identical with such registered office.
33	
34	4-26-502. Change of office or agent - Resignation of agent.
35	(a) A corporation may change its registered office or change its
36	registered agent, or both, by executing and filing, in accordance with § 4-

_	20 1201; a statement setting forth.
2	(1) The name of the corporation;
3	(2) The address, including street and number, if any, of its
4	then registered office;
5	(3) If the address of its registered office has changed, the
6	address, including street and number, if any, to which the registered office
7	is to be changed;

11	(6) That the address of its registered office and the address of

21	the county clerk is required.
22	(c)(1) In the event a registered agent for one (1) or more
23	corporations changed the address of his or its business office, which office
24	is the registered office of one (1) or more corporations, the registered
25	office of the corporations may be changed upon the filing by the registered
26	agent in the office of the Secretary of State of a statement setting forth:
27	(A) The name of the registered agent;
28	(B) The address of the business office of the registered
29	agent before the change;
30	(C) The address of the business office of the registered
31	agent after the change;
32	(D) The names of the corporations which have designated
33	the agent as their registered agent and which have their registered office at
34	the business office of the registered agent;
35	(E) That notice in writing of the change has been mailed
36	by the registered agent to each of these corporations:

1	(F) That the address of the registered office of each of
2	these corporations and the address of the business office of the registered
3	agent, as changed, will be identical.
4	(2) The statement shall be executed in duplicate by the
5	registered agent in his individual name; but, if the agent is a corporation,
6	domestic or foreign, it shall be executed and verified by its president or a
7	vice president and by its secretary or an assistant secretary.
8	(3) The statement so executed in duplicate shall be delivered to
9	the Secretary of State.
10	(4) If the Secretary of State finds that it conforms to law,
11	then upon the payment of the fees required under this chapter, he shall
12	endorse upon each of the duplicates tendered for filing, over his signature
13	and official seal, the word "FILED" followed by the date of the filing.
14	(5) The change of address of the registered office shall become
15	effective upon the filing of the statement by the Secretary of State.
16	(6) The Secretary of State shall retain in his files one (1)
17	executed copy of the statement, which shall be the ribbon copy of the
18	document if typewritten, and he shall attach to the other filed copy a
19	certificate stating that the instrument is an executed counterpart of a
20	statement filed in his office, giving date of the filing, and return the
21	other copy to the registered agent.
22	(7) If the new location of the registered office is situated in
23	any county other than Pulaski County, the executed counterpart of the
24	statement filed with the Secretary of State, with his certificate annexed
25	thereto, shall be filed for record within sixty (60) days after the date of
26	its filing with the Secretary of State in the office of the county clerk of
27	the county wherein the registered office is newly located. After recording
28	the statement, the county clerk shall return the statement to the registered
29	agent.
30	(d)(1) Any registered agent of a corporation may resign as agent by
31	executing a written resignation in duplicate and filing both counterparts
32	with the Secretary of State, one (1) of which shall be promptly mailed or
33	delivered by the Secretary of State to the corporation.
34	(2) The corporation, thereupon, shall designate a substituted
35	registered agent as provided in subsection (a) of this section.
36	(3) However, if the corporation fails to file the designation in

- 35 is given or withheld, the limited partnership shall, without demand, provide

- 2 (j) A limited partner or person dissociated as a limited partner may 3 exercise the rights under this section through an attorney or other agent.
- 4 Any restriction imposed under subsection (g) or by the partnership agreement
- 5 applies both to the attorney or other agent and to the limited partner or
- 6 person dissociated as a limited partner.
- 7 (k) The rights stated in this section do not extend to a person as
- 8 transferee, but may be exercised by the legal representative of an individual
- 9 under legal disability who is a limited partner or person dissociated as a
