10 INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION TO BE INFORMED AT
11 REGISTRATION IF A COURSE WILL TRANSFER TO ANOTHER
12 PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION; TO
13 REQUIRE THE EIGHT-SEMESTER COURSE OF STUDY TO
14 INCLUDE TRANSFERABILITY INFORMATION; AND FOR
15 OTHER PURPOSES.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 61, Subchapter 1 is amended
28 to add an additional section to read as follows:

29 6-61-131. Academic advising on transferability of coursework.

30 (a) The General Assembly finds that:

31 (1) Academic advising is an important service provided to
32 students;

33 (2) The Arkansas Course Transfer System (ACTS) is an important
34 tool for the advising process that is to be used by professors and advising
35 staff to improve graduation rates; and

36 (3) Freshman should be advised of the importance of academic



1 advising, the availability of the Arkansas Course Transfer System (ACTS), and
2 how to use Arkansas Course Transfer System (ACTS).

3 (b) Each public institution of higher education shall inform a student
4 at registration as to how the Arkansas Course Transfer System (ACTS) can be
5 used to assist the student to understand which course will transfer to
6 another public institution of higher education.

7 (c) The information provided to the student under this section shall
8 help the student use the Arkansas Course Transfer System (ACTS) to determine
9 which public institutions of higher education accept various courses for
10 transfer.
