2	(a) The members of the House Interim Committee on Aging, Children and
3	Youth, Legislative and Military Affairs and the Senate Interim Committee on

5	(1) Establish and maintain a continuing program of inspection
6	for each facility to which children are committed in the juvenile justice
7	<pre>system;</pre>
8	(2) Evaluate and assist in the development of programs to
9	improve the condition or operation of each facility to which children are

18	10-3-2404. Access to, inspection of, and monitoring of facilities.
19	(a) The members of the House Interim Committee on Aging, Children and
20	Youth, Legislative and Military Affairs and the Senate Interim Committee on
21	Children and Youth and the staff of the committees shall have the right to
22	enter into any part of any facility to which children are committed from the
23	juvenile justice system at any time during normal business hours without
24	advance notice.
25	(b) The members of the House Interim Committee on Aging, Children and
26	Youth, Legislative and Military Affairs and the Senate Interim Committee on
27	Children and Youth and the staff of the committees shall have the right to
28	inspect and monitor the facilities.
29	(c) This section applies to a facility that is operated by the state,
30	a political subdivision of the state, or a private entity under contract with
31	a state or local government.
