11 AN ACT TO PROTECT WOMEN WHO BREAST-FEED THEIR
12 CHILDREN; TO CREATE A CAUSE OF ACTION TO PREVENT
13 INTERFERENCE WITH THE BREASTFEEDING OF A CHILD;
14 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

17 AN ACT TO PROTECT WOMEN WHO BREAST-FEED

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-14-112, concerning indecent exposure, is
26 amended to read as follows:

27 (c) A woman is not in violation of this section for
28 breastfeeding a child in a public place or any place where other individuals
29 are present.

31 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 16, Chapter 118, Subchapter 1 is
32 amended to add an additional subchapter to read as follows:

33 16-118-109. Breastfeeding in public.

34 (a) A woman may breastfeed her baby in a public place or any other
35 place.

36 (b)(1) A woman who suffers a physical injury or extreme mental anguish



1 due to a violation of subsection (a) of this section may bring a civil action
2 for damages in a court of competent jurisdiction.

3 (2) If the plaintiff prevails in an action brought under
4 subdivision (b)(1) of this section, the court may award the plaintiff
5 reasonable attorney's fees and reasonable court costs.
