22	As used in this subchapter:
23	(1) "Amniotic fluid" means the fluid inside the amnion;
24	(2) "Nonembryonic stem cell research" means medical research
25	involving stem cells that have not been derived from a human embryo or fetus;
26	(3) "Placenta" means the organ that forms on the inner wall of
27	the human uterus during pregnancy;
28	(4) "Postnatal tissue and fluid" means the placenta, umbilical
29	cord, and amniotic fluid expelled or extracted in connection with the birth
30	of a human being;
31	(5) "Stem cell" means an unspecialized or undifferentiated cell
32	that can self-replicate and has the potential to differentiate into $\underline{a}$
33	specialized cell type; and
34	(6) "Umbilical cord" means the gelatinous tissue and blood
35	vessels connecting an unborn human being to the placenta.
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1	20-8-504. Newborn Umbilical Cord Blood Initiative.
2	(a)(1) On or before June 30, 2008, the Arkansas Commission for the
3	Newborn Umbilical Cord Blood Initiative shall establish a network of
4	postnatal tissue and fluid banks in partnership with one (1) or more public
5	or private colleges or universities, public or private hospitals, nonprofit
6	organizations, or private firms in this state for the purpose of collecting
7	and storing postnatal tissue and fluid.
8	(2) The Newborn Umbilical Cord Blood Bank shall create a
9	voluntary program to make tissue and fluid available for scientific research
10	and medical treatment in accordance with this subchapter.
11	(3) A parent of a child born in this state may voluntarily
12	contribute postnatal tissue and fluid to the Newborn Umbilical Cord Blood
13	Bank.
14	(b)(1) The commission shall develop a voluntary program to educate
15	pregnant patients with respect to the banking of postnatal tissue and fluid.
16	(2) The program shall include:
17	(A) An explanation of the difference between public and
18	private postnatal tissue and fluid banking programs;
19	(B) The medical process involved in the collection and
20	storage of postnatal tissue and fluid;
21	(C) The current and potential future medical uses of
22	stored postnatal tissue and fluid;
23	(D) The benefits and risks involved in the banking of
24	postnatal tissue and fluid; and
25	(E) The availability and cost of storing postnatal tissue
26	and fluid in public and private umbilical cord blood banks.

28	20-8-505. Arkansas Commission for the Newborn Umbilical Cord Blood
29	<u>Initiative - Creation - Members.</u>
30	(a) The Arkansas Commission for the Newborn Umbilical Cord Blood
31	<u>Initiative</u> is created.
32	(b)(1) The commission shall consist of eleven (11) members appointed
33	as follows:
34	(A) Three (3) members appointed by the Governor as
35	follows:
36	(i) One (1) member who is a physician licensed by

1	the Arkansas State Medical Board;
2	(ii) One (1) member who has a financial background;
3	<u>and</u>
4	(iii) One (1) member who has a legal background or
5	an ethicist background, or both;
6	(B) Three (3) members appointed by the Speaker of the
7	House of Representatives as follows:;
8	(i) One (1) member who is a physician licensed by
9	the Arkansas State Medical Board;
10	(ii) One (1) member who has a financial background;

26	(2) The commission shall include one (1) consultant, nonvoting
27	member who shall be the Director of Cell Therapy and Transfusion Medicine of

29	(c) The Governor shall designate one (1) member as chair of the
30	<pre>commission.</pre>
31	(d) The chair shall call the first meeting of the commission within
32	sixty (60) days of his or her appointment.
33	(e)(1) At the first meeting of the commission, the members shall draw
34	lots so that three (3) members serve two-year terms, three (3) members serve
35	three-year terms, and three (3) members serve four-year terms.
36	(2) After the initial terms members shall serve four-year

2	(f) The commission shall meet at least quarterly.
3	(g)(1) A majority of the membership of the commission shall constitute

12	<u>Initiative - Powers and duties.</u>
13	(a) The Arkansas Commission for the Newborn Umbilical Cord Blood
14	<u>Initiative shall:</u>
15	(1) Investigate the implementation of this subchapter and
16	recommend improvements in this subchapter to the General Assembly;
17	(2) Make available to the public the records of all meetings of
18	the commission and of all business transacted by the commission;
19	(3) Oversee the operations of the Newborn Umbilical Cord Blood
20	Bank, including without limitation the approval of all fees established to
21	cover administration, collection, and storage costs;
22	(4) Undertake the Newborn Umbilical Cord Blood Initiative by
23	promoting awareness of the blood bank and encouraging donation of postnatal
24	tissue and fluid to the blood bank;
25	(5) Ensure the privacy of persons who donate umbilical cord
26	blood, amniotic fluid, and placental tissue to the blood bank;
27	(6) Develop a plan for making postnatal tissue and fluid
28	collected under the Newborn Umbilical Cord Blood Initiative available for
29	scientific research and medical treatment in compliance with all relevant
30	national practice and quality standards;
31	(7) Develop a plan for private storage of postnatal tissue and
32	fluid for medical treatment;
33	(8) Participate in the National Cord Blood Program and register
34	postnatal tissue and fluid collected with registries operating in connection
35	with the program;
36	(9) If funds are available, employ staff and enter into

1	contracts necessary to implement this subchapter; and
2	(10) Report annually to the General Assembly on or before
3	October 1 of each year concerning the activities of the commission.
4	(b) The commission may seek additional funding from any source,
5	including without limitation federal grants and private grants.

7	20-8-507. Income tax check-off program for contributions to the
8	Newborn Umbilical Cord Blood Initiative.
9	(a)(1) It is the purpose of this section to provide a means by which
10	an individual taxpayer may designate a portion or all of his or her income
11	tax refund to be withheld and contributed for the purposes set forth in this
12	section.
13	(2) It is the intent of the General Assembly that the income tax
14	check-off program established in this section is supplemental to any funding
15	and in no way is intended to take the place of funding that would otherwise
16	be appropriated for this purpose.
17	(b) The Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and
18	Administration shall include on the Arkansas individual income tax forms,
19	$\underline{\text{including those forms on which a husband and wife file separately on the same}$
20	form and on all corporate income tax forms, a designation as follows:
21	"(1) If you are entitled to a refund, check if you wish to
22	designate [ ] \$1, [ ] \$5, [ ] \$10, [ ] \$20, [ ] \$ (write in
23	amount), or [ ] all refund due, of your tax refund for the Newborn Umbilical
24	Cord Blood Initiative. Your refund will be reduced by this amount."
25	"(2) If you owe an additional amount, check if you wish to
26	contribute an additional [ ] \$1, [ ] \$5, [ ] \$10, [ ] \$20, [ ] \$
27	(write in amount) for the Newborn Umbilical Cord Blood
28	Initiative. If you wish to make a contribution to the program, you must
29	enclose a separate check for the amount of your contribution, payable to the
30	Newborn Umbilical Cord Blood Initiative."
31	(c) The department shall certify quarterly to the Treasurer of State
32	the amount contributed to the program through this state income tax checkoff
33	during the quarter as authorized by this section, and the Treasurer of State
34	shall deduct from the Income Tax Withholding Fund the amount so certified.
35	(d) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall
36	promulgate all rules and all income tax forms, returns, and schedules
