2	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
3	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the 2006 Act 57 study		
4	recommended that foundation funding and categorical funding be increased for		
5	the 2007-2008 and 2008-2009 school years; that the method of calculating the		
6	state foundation funding aid should be changed to ensure that all public		
7	school districts receive the full amount of foundation funding; and that this
