TO ALLOW AN ELECTIVE CREDIT FOR
COMPLETING A BOARD-AUTHORIZED ONLINE
COURSE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 16, Subchapter 1 is amended
to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-16-140. Academic credit for online courses.

The Department of Education shall develop and implement a program under
which students in grades nine through twelve (9-12) may receive one (1)
elective credit that may be applied toward graduation for satisfactorily
completing a board-authorized online course.
