17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 Section 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 10, Subchapter 1 is amended  
20 to add an additional section as follows:

21 6-10-121. Tornado safety drills.

22 (a)(1) As used in this section, "public school" means a school that is  
23 part of a public school district under the control and management of a local  
24 school district board of directors.

25 (2) "Public school" includes the Arkansas School for  
26 Mathematics, Sciences, and the Arts, the Arkansas School for the Deaf, the  
27 Arkansas School for the Blind, and juvenile detention centers.

28 (b) It shall be the duty of the Director of the Arkansas Department of  
29 Emergency Management to require all public schools to conduct tornado safety  
30 drills not less than four (4) times per year in the months of September,  
31 October, January, and February.
