9 AN ACT TO CONTINUE THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT
10 PROVISIONS AFFECTING THE RECORDS AND MEETINGS OF
11 PUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

14 TO CONTINUE THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION
15 ACT PROVISIONS AFFECTING THE RECORDS AND
16 MEETINGS OF PUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 25-19-103(6), as amended by Act 268 of the*
22 *2007 Regular Session and concerning the definition of "public water system",*
23 *is amended to read as follows:*

24 *(6)(A) "Public water system" means all facilities composing a*
25 *system for the collection, treatment, and delivery of drinking water to the*
26 *general public, including, but not limited to, reservoirs, pipelines,*
27 *reclamation facilities, processing facilities, and distribution facilities.*

28 *(B) This subdivision (6) shall expire on July 1, 2009; and*

30 *SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 25-19-105(b)(15) and (16), as amended by*
31 *Act 268 of the 2007 Regular Session, are amended to add an additional*
32 *subdivision to read as follows:*

33 *(15) Military service discharge records or DD Form 214, the*
34 *Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty of the United States*
35 *Department of Defense, filed with the county recorder as provided under § 14-*
36 *2-102, for veterans discharged from service less than seventy (70) years from*

2 (16) Vulnerability assessments submitted by a public water
3 system on or before June 30, 2004, to the Administrator of the United States
4 Environmental Protection Agency for a period of ten (10) years from the date
5 of submission; and

6 (17)(A) Records, including analyses, investigations, studies,
7 reports, recommendations, requests for proposals, drawings, diagrams,
8 blueprints, and plans, containing information relating to security for any
9 public water system.

10 (B) The records shall include:

11 (i) Risk and vulnerability assessments;

12 (ii) Plans and proposals for preventing and
13 mitigating security risks;

14 (iii) Emergency response and recovery records;

15 (iv) Security plans and procedures; and

16 (v) Any other records containing information that if
17 disclosed might jeopardize or compromise efforts to secure and protect the
18 public water system.

19 (C) This subdivision (b)(17) shall expire on July 1, 2009.

20
21 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 25-19-106(c), concerning the expiration
22 date for a public agency to meet in executive session about a public water
23 system security, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as
24 follows:

25 (6)(A) Subject to the provisions of subdivision (c)(4) of this
26 section, any public agency may meet in executive session for the purpose of
27 considering, evaluating, or discussing matters pertaining to public water
28 system security as described in § 25-19-105(b)(17).

29 (B) This subdivision (c)(6) shall expire on July 1, 2009.

30
31 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
32 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain provisions in the
33 Freedom of Information Act concerning the records and meetings of public
34 water systems will expire on July 1, 2007; that those provisions are
35 necessary to ensure that public water systems are operated and managed safely
36 and effectively; and that this act is necessary in order to provide security

1 for public water systems. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and
2 this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health,
3 and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2007.
