20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 12, Chapter 75, Subchapter 1 is amended
23 to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

24 12-75-133. Immunity for volunteers.

25 (a) An individual is not liable for negligently causing the death of
26 or injury to any person or for the loss of or damage to the property of a
27 person resulting from the aid rendered during a disaster declared under the
28 Arkansas Emergency Services Act of 1973 § 12-75-101 et seq. if:

29 (1) The individual was a medical, dental, or other health care
30 professional licensed by the state or a political subdivision of the state;

31 (2) The individual was rendering aid voluntarily and without
32 compensation;

33 (3) The aid rendered involved the professional skill for which
34 the individual was licensed;

35 (4) The aid was rendered to assist a person injured as a result
36 of the disaster; and
