9 AN ACT TO ENLARGE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ELEVATOR  
10 SAFETY BOARD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

13 TO ENLARGE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE  
14 ELEVATOR SAFETY BOARD.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-24-105 is amended to read as follows:  
20 20-24-105. Elevator Safety Board - Creation - Members.

21 (a) There is created the Elevator Safety Board, consisting of ~~five (5)~~  
22 six (6) members, one (1) of whom shall be the Director of the Department of  
23 Labor, who shall serve continuously, and ~~four (4)~~ five (5) of whom shall be  
24 appointed by the Governor for terms of four (4) years.

25 (b) Upon the death, resignation, or incapacity of any member, the  
26 Governor shall fill the vacancy, for the remainder of the unexpired term,  
27 with a representative of the same interests as those of his or her  
28 predecessor.

29 (c) Of the ~~four (4) appointed~~ five (5) members appointed by the  
30 Governor:

31 (1) One (1) shall be a representative of the owners and lessees  
32 of elevators within this state;

33 (2) One (1) shall be a representative of the manufacturers of  
34 elevators used within this state;

35 (3) One (1) shall be a representative of an insurance company  
36 authorized to insure the operation of elevators in this state; ~~and~~

(4) One (1) shall be a representative of the public at large;

and

(5) One (1) shall be selected from a list of persons recommended by the board of trustees of the Elevator Industry Work Preservation Fund.

(d) The board shall meet at the call of the director who shall designate in the call the time and place of the meeting.

(e) The members except the director may receive expense reimbursement and stipends in accordance with § 25-16-901 et seq.
