## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-18-206, concerning public school choice, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
(j)(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, any other state law, State Board of Education rule, or local school district policy, a child residing in a residential subdivision that is within the boundaries of two (2) or more school districts may attend any school district with boundaries encompassing a portion of the subdivision.
(2) (A) For purposes of this subsection ( $j$ ), "residential subdivision" means land divided for predominantly residential purposes into parcels as required by local ordinances.
(B) In the absence of a local ordinance, the term "residential subdivision" means any land that is divided:
(i) By a common owner or owners for predominantly residential purposes into three (3) or more lots or parcels, any of which contain fewer than three (3) acres; or
(ii) Into platted or unplatted units any of which
