17	exploitation to dominate a spouse;
18	(C) Criminally harassing a spouse;
19	(D) Stalking a spouse;
20	(E) Threatening a spouse or his or her loved ones;

12	The purpose of the Spousal Abuse Safety Plan Act is to:

17	children as safe as possible by developing publications as described under §
18	9-15-405 on what to do and where to go if danger occurs;
