1	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-60-502 is amended to read as follows:
2	(a) No part-time student housed in on-campus premises and no full-time
3	student may attend a public or private college or university in this state
4	unless he or she has furnished proof, within such time as set by the college
5	or university, but not to exceed thirty (30) calendar days after enrollment,
6	by way of an official record from another educational institution in Arkansas
7	or a certificate from a licensed medical doctor or an authorized public
8	health department representative, that he or she has immunity against
9	measles, rubella, and such other diseases <u>except sexually transmitted</u>
10	diseases as delineated by the State Board of Health.
11	(b) The board may establish a voluntary program through which:
12	(1) A college student may elect to be immunized against sexually
