## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE CITY, COUNTY, AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS TO WAIVE THE FOURTEEN-DAY LIMIT ON TEMPORARY FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES .

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-57-204(e), concerning permit required for temporary food establishment, is amended to read as follows:
(e)(1)(A) A temporary food establishment permit shall be procured from the Division of Environmental Health Protection by any temporary facility operating at a fixed location for a period of not more than fourteen (14) consecutive days in conjunction with a single event or celebration.
(2) (B) A fee of five dollars (\$5.00) shall be charged per day for each temporary food establishment permit.
(2)(A) The fourteen-consecutive-day limit under subdivision (e)(l)(A)of this section may be waived by a city, county, or local government if the temporary food establishment is located within the area of jurisdiction of the city, county, or local government.
(B) If the fourteen-consecutive-day limit under subdivision (e)(1)(A) of this section is waived under subdivision (e)(2)(A)

of this section, the temporary food establishment shall be charged a temporary food establishment fee of five dollars (\$5.00) per day but not to exceed seventy dollars (\$70.00).
