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## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO CREATE A COUNTY ASSESSORS CONTINUING  
10 EDUCATION BOARD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

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12 TO CREATE A COUNTY ASSESSORS CONTINUING  
13 EDUCATION BOARD.  
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 14, Chapter 15, Subchapter 2 is amended  
21 to add an additional section to read as follows:

22 14-15-206. County Assessors Continuing Education Board

23 (a) There is created the County Assessors Continuing Education Board  
24 which shall be composed of the following six (6) members:

25 (1)(A) Five (5) members appointed by the Governor from a list of  
26 at least ten (10) persons submitted by the Arkansas Assessors Association.

27 (B)(i) Two (2) of the members shall be contractors or  
28 appraisers who have at a minimum a Level 4 certification.

29 (ii) Three (3) of the members shall be assessors or  
30 deputy assessors who have at a minimum a Level 4 certification; and

31 (2) The Director of the Assessment Coordination Department or a  
32 person designated by the director.

33 (b) The members of the board shall attend board meetings at their own  
34 expense.

35 (c) It shall be the responsibility of the County Assessors Continuing  
36 Education Board to:



1           (1) Maintain communication with the county assessors and other  
2 assessment professionals in Arkansas to determine their educational needs;

3           (2) Convey educational needs and concerns of the county  
4 assessors and other assessment professionals in Arkansas and to work in  
5 conjunction with any education committee or workgroup:

6                   (A) Formed by the Assessment Coordination Department's  
7 rule; and

8                   (B) Composed of representatives from all sectors of the  
9 assessing profession in Arkansas;

10           (3) Plan educational seminars to provide county assessors and  
11 other assessment professionals the opportunity to achieve professional  
12 designations and earn continuing education credits to maintain those  
13 designations;

14           (4) Plan educational seminars to provide county assessors and  
15 other assessment professionals the opportunity to improve their ability to  
16 carry out their official responsibilities in an efficient and effective  
17 manner; and

18           (5) Approve the expenditures of the County Assessors' Continuing  
19 Education Trust Fund disbursed by the Assessment Coordination Department.
