## For An Act To Be Entitled

10 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS LAW CONCERNING THE  
11 GOVERNOR'S POWER TO ISSUE A PARDON TO ANY PERSON  
12 CONVICTED FOR VIOLATING LAWS AGAINST THE UNLAWFUL  
13 MANUFACTURE OR SALE OF LIQUORS; AND FOR OTHER  
14 PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

17 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS LAW CONCERNING  
18 THE GOVERNOR'S POWER TO ISSUE A PARDON  
19 TO ANY PERSON CONVICTED FOR VIOLATING

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-2-102 is repealed.

27 ~~3-2-102. Governor's pardoning power restricted.~~

28 ~~(a) It is declared to be an abuse of power and an impeachable offense~~  
29 ~~for the Governor to issue a pardon to any person convicted for violating any~~  
30 ~~of the laws of this state against the unlawful manufacture or sale of liquors~~  
31 ~~amounting to a felony, except on proof that the person was not guilty.~~

32 ~~(b) However, the Governor may issue to the person a short furlough not~~  
33 ~~to exceed ninety (90) days in the aggregate in any one (1) year.~~
