21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 27, Subchapter 2 is amended
24 to add additional sections to read as follows:

25 5-27-211. Sale of canned air containing tetrafluoroethane to a minor.

26 (a) It is unlawful to knowingly sell canned compressed air containing
27 tetrafluoroethane to a minor.

28 (b) Upon conviction, any person who violates this section is guilty of
29 a Class B misdemeanor.
30

31 5-27-212. Purchase or possession of canned air containing
32 tetrafluoroethane by a minor.

33 (a) It is unlawful for a minor to knowingly purchase or attempt to
34 purchase canned compressed air containing tetrafluoroethane.

35 (b)(1) It is unlawful for a minor to knowingly possess canned
36 compressed air containing tetrafluoroethane without the supervision of a



1 parent, guardian, or teacher.

2 (2) The canned compressed air containing tetrafluoroethane that
3 is unlawfully possessed by a minor may be seized by a law enforcement officer
4 as contraband.

5 (c) Upon conviction, any person who violates this section is guilty of
6 a Class B misdemeanor.
