Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO SELL CANNED COMPRESSED AIR CONTAINING TETRAFLUOROETHANE TO A MINOR; TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL FOR A MINOR TO POSSESS CANNED COMPRESSED AIR CONTAINING TETRAFLUOROETHANE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO SELL CANNED
COMPRESSED AIR CONTAINING
TETRAFLUOROETHANE TO A MINOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 27, Subchapter 2 is amended to add additional sections to read as follows:

5-27-211. Sale of canned air containing tetrafluoroethane to a minor.
(a) It is unlawful to knowingly sell canned compressed air containing tetrafluoroethane to a minor.
(b) Upon conviction, any person who violates this section is guilty of a Class B misdemeanor.

5-27-212. Purchase or possession of canned air containing tetrafluoroethane by a minor.
(a) It is unlawful for a minor to knowingly purchase or attempt to purchase canned compressed air containing tetrafluoroethane.
(b) (l) It is unlawful for a minor to knowingly possess canned compressed air containing tetrafluoroethane without the supervision of a
parent, guardian, or teacher.
(2) The canned compressed air containing tetrafluoroethane that is unlawfully possessed by a minor may be seized by a law enforcement officer as contraband.
(c) Upon conviction, any person who violates this section is guilty of a Class $B$ misdemeanor.
