19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 26-26-1906(c), concerning computer-assisted
22 mass appraisal systems, is amended to read as follows:

23 (c) The department shall have access ~~and the capability to retrieve to~~
24 the data stored in each county's computer-assisted mass appraisal system via
25 phone lines and a modem, common-use technologies as determined by the
26 department including without limitation:

- 27 (1) The Internet;
 - 28 (2) Network technologies;
 - 29 (3) Phone line and modem technologies;
 - 30 (4) Compact disk technologies;
 - 31 (5) Magnetic tape technologies; or
 - 32 (6) Other similar common-use technologies.
