24	functions are performed under $\underline{\text{the}}$ supervision of a licensed professional		
25	counselor.		
26	(d) Nothing contained in this subchapter prohibits an individual who		
27	is not licensed under this chapter and who works in a self-help group, a		
28	self-help program, or a not-for-profit organization or agency from providing		
29	services or pastoral counseling in the self-help group, the self-help		
30	program, or the not-for-profit organization or agency.
