21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-7-305(c)(1), concerning the candidate's
24 name on a ballot, is amended to read as follows:

25 (c)(1)(A) Any person who shall file for any elective office in this
26 state may use not more than three (3) given names, one (1) of which may be a
27 nickname or any other word used for the purpose of identifying the person to
28 the voters, and may add as a prefix to his or her name the title or an
29 abbreviation of an elective public office the person currently holds.

30 ~~(B) A person may only use the prefix "Judge", "Justice",~~
31 ~~or "Chief Justice" in an election for a judgeship if the person is currently~~
32 ~~serving in a judicial position to which the person has been elected.~~

33 ~~(C)(B)~~ A nickname shall not include a professional or
34 honorary title.
