12	(a) There is established the Arkansas Rehabilitation Services					
13	Forgiveness of Student Loan Program to assist counselors employed by the					
14	Arkansas Rehabilitation Services with the repayment of student loans.					
15	(b)(1) The program shall be administered by the Arkansas					
16	Rehabilitation Services of the Department of Workforce Education.					
17	(2) The Arkansas Rehabilitation Services shall promulgate rules					
18	<pre>for determining:</pre>					
19	(A) A counselor's eligibility for a loan under the program					
20	which shall include the following requirements:					
21	(i) Satisfactory completion of any probationary					
22	<pre>employment period;</pre>					
23	(ii) Proof of a student loan that remains unpaid,					
24	including the name and address of the creditor; and					
25	(iii) An executed employment contract in which the					
26	counselor agrees to:					
27	(a) Work for the Arkansas Rehabilitation					
28	Services for a term that equals two (2) years for each year that the program					
29	makes a payment on the counselor's student loan; and					
30	(b) Reimburse the program the full amount of					
31	any loan payments made under this program in the event that the counselor					
32	resigns or is terminated for cause before the term of the contract					
33	terminates.					
34	(B) The amount of the payment to be made directly to the					
35	counselor's student loan creditor may not exceed:					
36	(i) Two thousand dollars (\$2,000) per year; or
